

Raritan recently introduced a new IP User Station for the **Dominion KX III digital KVM switch**, Raritan's flagship enterprise-class KVM-over IP switch that provides 1, 2, 4 or 8 users with BIOS-level remote management of 8, 16, 32 or 64 servers in a single switch. The Dominion KX III is suitable for server rooms, test labs, and the largest enterprise data centers.

For broadcast, control rooms, labs and studios, the new KX III User Station provides high-performance, KVM-over-IP access in a self-contained, low-maintenance appliance.
