As the first offering in the Easy Connect portfolio, the Managed Hybrid solution features "tightly integrated" compute, storage and networking paired with Zynstra virtualisation and cloud management software. The system is preconfigured to install in a short time, and it can handle taks both on-premise and in the cloud according to user choice.

The cloud also takes care of pre-integrated services (such as Microsoft Office 365 and Azure), maintenance, patches and upgrades, eliminating the need for on-site IT staff. Customers can pay for software licenses on a subscription basis instead of up-front.

"Small businesses want to focus on growing their core businesses, not spending their limited resources on deploying and managing IT," the company says.
