SD-WAN Go uses either existing or new connections (private, dedicated, broadband or 4G) to securely tunnel and route data across the public internet and over the Masergy software-defined platform. It is "transport-agnostic," with a "bring-your-own-bandwidth" model allowing it to interoperate with 3rd party vendor circuits or WANs. Masergy can also provide the connection.

Further features include zero-touch provisioning, WAN optimisation, local internet offload, centralised policy and configuration management and PoP-to-cloud SLAs.

“Adopting SD-WAN Go is like moving from a paper map to Google Maps. We give users real-time visibility into their WANs,” the company says. “SD-WAN Go lets businesses rapidly and securely add locations and introduce network intelligence to meet their application performance needs.”
