

Barcelona Hosts In(3D)ustry 3D Printing Congress

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The Catalan city of Barcelona hosts the first edition of In(3D)ustry From Needs to Solutions-- an event focusing on industrial 3D printing.



Held at the Italian Pavilion of Fira Barcelona in Montjuïc, the show features a conference area with experts discussing the state of the 3D printing industry, as well as a showcase of 50 different solutions as divided across Retail and Consumer Goods, Healthcare, Automotive and Aeronautics, Architecture and Habitat, and Miscellaneous segments.

The show is co-founded by HP, whose global 3D printing development centre is actually found in the Barcelona metropolitan area, specifically at the town of Sant Cugat del Vàlles. As such, the company will be showing off its [Multi Jet Fusion technology](#).

Also found at the show is the Innovation Marketplace, an area described by the organisers as "a meeting point where major corporations and specialised investors will meet the best innovative additive and advanced manufacturing solutions."

In(3D)ustry takes place on 21-23 June 2016.

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
