

Ricoh's Unified Communication System, the P3500M

In USA, **Ricoh** announces its **Unified Communication System, the P3500M** — a portable, all-in-one system the size of a laptop. The device weighs 1.58kg device and includes an HD camera, microphone and speakers (inside a soft carrying case).

An upgrade to the P3500 which won the IF Design Award in 2015, the P3500M's **2.0 megapixel camera** includes a 125-degree wide-angle lens. It can be unpacked, plugged in, connected and ready in one minute. Additionally

Mobile workers can stay connected no matter what WebRTC-supportive platforms their collaborators are using. P3500M can support numerous locations using a variety of collaboration technologies, with the ability to display 9 locations simultaneously. The system includes business-class security such as encrypted data streams over wireless networks.

The RICOH Unified Communication System P3500M will be available in the summer.

Using the P3500M, organizations can achieve new levels of collaboration. Employees can connect and collaborate with colleagues or customers on the road or around the world, via real-time HD video and audio, and screen sharing, regardless of which WebRTC-supportive
