

InFocus Intros Mondopad Ultra

InFocus announces the Mondopad Ultra-- a 70-inch touchscreen collaboration system combining video conferencing, interactive whiteboarding, presentation and data sharing.



The Mondopad features a 4K (3840x2160) resolution display and enables teams to connect and share any type of content with local and remote audiences. It team members in multiple locations to see and hear each other while brainstorming on a shared whiteboard, with real-time collaboration including document editing and onscreen drawing.

Users can save documents directly on the Mondopad, to the network or email to anyone directly from the device, while the built-in camera and speakers provide enterprise-grade video conferencing. Advanced wireless casting, including AirPlay, Chrome and Miracast, allow presenters to share content from laptops and mobile devices without need for cables or dongles.

Powering the Mondopad are an Intel Core i7-6700T CPU, Q170 chipset with Intel vPro technology, 8GB RAM and 256GB SSD. It integrates securely into enterprise infrastructure, and support for SIP and H.232 make it compatible with legacy video conferencing and display hardware and software, including Skype for Business and many 3rd party room video conferencing systems.

The MonoPad Ultra is available from October 2016.

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
