The CS-700 SIP model introduces VoIP capability, with built-in connections for VoIP and USB for UC applications. Thus, users can not only conference via audio and video from any UC platforms, they can also bridge VoIP and USB calls directly from the device.

Aimed at huddle rooms and other small conferencing environments, the series includes two models-- the CS-700AV and CS-700SP.
