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Bose and Sennheiser announce a collaboration at ISE 2020 to bring about the ES1 Ceiling Audio Solution, an in-ceiling solution optimised for use with unified communication platforms aimed at conference rooms.



The solution bundles the Sennheiser TeamConnect Ceiling 2 microphone and three Bose products, namely the ControlSpace EX-440C conferencing digital signal processor, the EdgeMax EM180 in-ceiling loudspeaker and the PowerSpace P2600A amplifier. The result, the two companies say, is a high performance and easy to use audio solution with no devices on the walls and tabletops.
