

Yealink to Bring Out IP Video Phone VP-2009 by Year End

By year-end, Yealink will release an IP video phone, VP-2009, equipped with the TI DaVinci chipset.

It features 7" touch screen color LCD and 300K pixels CMOS camera, enabling video conversation by the H.264 codec even at low bandwidth.

VP-2009 is a multimedia terminal which supports audio/video playing through Local Media Player or remote media streaming server (IPTV & VoD). Comes with USB, headset, A/V out, PSTN lifeline, 64M flash and 128M DDR2 memory. User can access internet through the browser and phone supports digital photo frame and the pictures could be loaded locally.
