

Netgear M4300 Switches Get Crestron Certification

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The Netgear M4300 series switches receive official Crestron certification for DM NVX AV-over-IP solutions, meaning the switches work out of the box with Crestron DM NVX encoders and decoders.



According to the company, most other network switches on the Crestron Certified list require a configuration file to function properly. This is not the case with the M4300 switches, since they ship preconfigured and require no further setup to work with Crestron hardware.

The M4300 series switches are engineered for AV over IP installations, and offer a variety of models fitting most port count and connection type requirements. They can be stacked, allowing for future expansion needs. Netgear IGMP Plus ensures easy multicasting with Zero Touch network configuration out of the box without flooding the network.

Further features include PoE, IGMPv3, IGMP snooping, IGMP fast-leave and a non-blocking backplane to ensure proper multicasting of any top of AV over IP protocol.

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
