

Toshiba Intros Portégé R30 Laptop

Toshiba announces the Portégé R30, a 13-inch laptop designed for SMB customers wanting a portable PC alternative complete with 4th generation Intel Mobile Performance processor and built-in DVD drive.



As well as the aforementioned Intel Mobile Performance processor, specifications include up to 16GB DDR3 memory and either 1TB hybrid HDD or 512GB SSD. Handling security are built-in Intel vPro technology, Trusted Platform Module (TPM) and a fingerprint reader, while connectivity includes three USB 3.0 ports, full-size HDMI, LAN port and media card reader.

Chassis construction is in magnesium alloy complete with shock-absorbing design, honeycomb reinforcement structure and Toshiba EasyGuard technology.

"As today's SMB businesses have become increasingly reliant on mobility, they need a laptop that is ultra-portable, but without sacrificing the performance and features of an enterprise class PC," the company says. "The Portégé R30 offers full performance, durability and battery life in a slim, 13-inch form factor, enabling increased productivity and flexibility for mobile workers, at an affordable price point and an unmatched quality guarantee."
