

Panasonic Upgrades Toughpad 4K Tablet

Panasonic upgrades the 20-inch Toughpad 4K Performance tablet (model FZ-Y1D), with improvements aimed at visual-intensive industries such as photography, videography, CAD and high-end retail.



The device now carries an Intel Core i7-5600U v Pro processor and an AMD FirePro M5100 GPU, while the OS of choice is either Windows 10 Pro or Windows 7 Professional. HDMI 2.0 input with support for Digital Cinema 4K (4096x2160@60fps) allows videographers and photographers to use it as a 20-inch 3840x2560 resolution viewfinder, as well as mobile workstation.

To secure the connection between tablet and source the Toughpad 4K features HDCP 2.2 for DRM duties.

The Windows 10 version of the upgraded Toughpad 4K Performance is available from November 2015. A Windows 7 model will follow on January 2016.
