Among such additions include enhanced chart and graph design, layout and rendering configurations, with a streamlined and more responsive HTML5 client UI.

Assessments and surveys get new branch and skip logic (with automatic reuse of recurring answers, flexible question types and matrix questioning), the platform gets more connectors (including IBM z-Secure, qRadar, JIRA and ServiceNow) and rich business intelligence (BI) functionality allows dashboard definition complete with drill-down capabilities and automatic report exports.

A library of 170 out-of-the-box functions increases flexibility, while accelerated data processing allows faster data integration, correlation searching and calculations.

Mainframe OS compatibility also includes the IBM Z/OS and z-Linux platforms.

"Businesses that once struggled to fully extract knowledge from their big data now have a tool that automates risk data aggregation and analysis down to the smallest detail," Brinqa says. "The output helps provide a complete understanding of consequences in "what-if" scenarios, allowing C-level executives to make more informed decisions on risk within their organisations."
