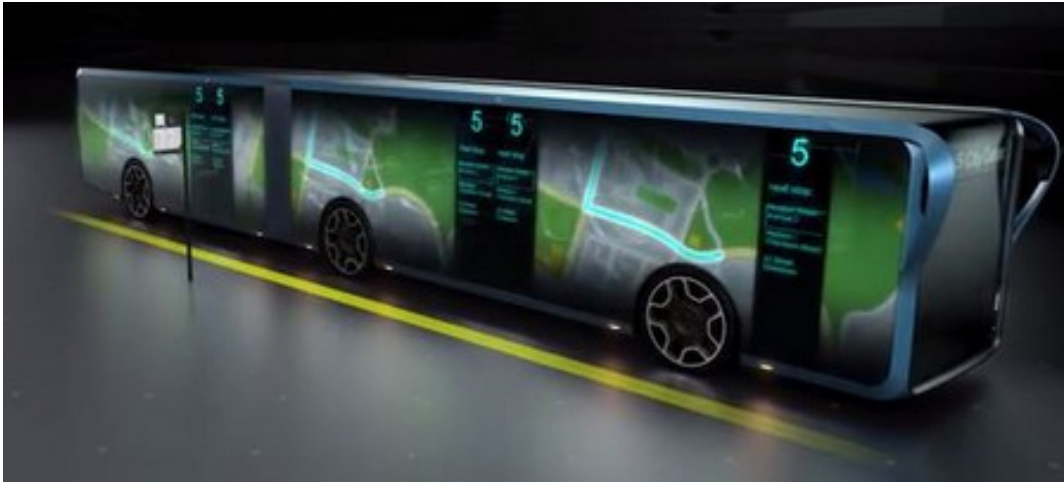


Meet the “Willie” Bus
