Also available is the **TDX series** (55", 65", 70", 84", 98") with responsive touch technology and a dual operating system platform (Android embedded and optional slots in Windows PC.)

The company also showed its **WDL-3500i Laser Projector**, an ultra-short throw interactive laser projector with DLP Technology and WXGA resolution that can give users as much as 115 inches of viewing.
