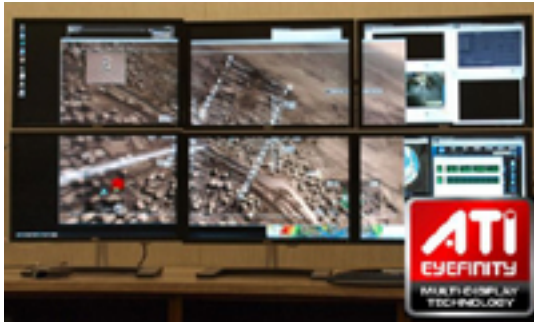


ATI Eyefinity's Panoramic Future

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A display adapter to extend the computer to multiple separate displays in multiple positions or nearby locations, ATI Eyefinity transforms the relationship of the PC and the display.

AMD expects ATI Eyefinity to simplify deployment of many commercial solutions and open new avenues for home computing.

Previously, one user employs one PC with one workspace spanning one or two monitors. Now the paradigm evolves to several new-use models (all modify the single-session/ single person /single screen paradigm).

Simon Solotko, Sr. Advanced Marketing Manager at AMD calls the first model Immersive, Panoramic Computing. Many displays for one person.

The other models he calls Crowd Computing. Many people, computing together, using many screens in many rooms with uniform and easy access to their user-settings, information, applications and powerful computer resources.

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
