Archipod is a self-contained, efficient wooden facility, designed to complement a garden. I



Designed as an insulated sphere 3m in diameter, the 'Pod' is constructed predominantly from timber, the world's most replenishable construction material and is insulated to a standard exceeding that of current Building Regulations. A larger 4m version Fatpod) is also available.

The structure is built from prefabricated sections so that all the parts can be carried through a house and into a back garden. Because of its unique shape and the generous natural light from the roof dome, the 'Pod' actually looks and feels bigger on the inside than the outside.

The unit is delivered, installed and equipped as an integrated package, including a state-of-the-art HD videoconferencing system. Only an electricity supply and a broadband connection from the house are required (and in UK planning permission is not normally necessary).
